MINTHIS HILLS GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

A ball is out of bounds if it is: a.) Over any boundary fence, hedge or wall b.) Beyond any line of white stakes.

2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

a.)Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes b.) Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes c.)The extend of hazard is defined by walls/concrete.

3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)

Is defined by blue stakes and/or signs - relief must be taken in all situations!

4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (rule 24.2)

a.) All tarmac and gravel paths b.) All walls adjacent to paths/ditches/hazards c.) Stone tee and directional /information plaques d.) All irrigation pipes e.) All bridges f.) Staked trees and trees with stakes adjacent-relief must be taken g.) Fixed sprinkler heads, in addition, if such obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows - If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be marked, lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which:

i. Is not nearer the hole ii. Avoids such intervention and iii. Is not a hazard or on a putting green

5. GRAVEL/STONE AREAS (Rules 24.2b)

Gravel or stone areas around tees and access paths to and from tees and greens are to be considered as "Immovable Obstructions" from which relief may be taken.

6. MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (rule 24.1)

Stones in bunkers, bunker rakes and all stakes on the course with the exception of boundary stakes and out of bounds markers.

7. ISLAND GREEN - HOLE 13

A ball entering the water surrounding the green may with a penalty of one shot be: a.)dropped in the designated drop zones or b.) On the teeing ground – The ball to be played must be played from within the teeing ground. It may be played from anywhere within the teeing ground and may be teed. c) Through the green – The ball to be played must be dropped and when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

8. BELL AT 6TH GREEN

Please ring the bell after putting out on the 6^{th} hole to indicate that the green is clear.

OTHER TEMPORARY/SEASONAL LOCAL RULES ARE DISPLAYED ON THE NOTICE BOARD.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE: MATCH PLAY - LOSS OF HOLE | STROKE PLAY - 2 STROKES.
