LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27)

- Beyond all fences and walls bounding the course.
- The area of the practice the nursery grass, putting green, the maintenance building on the right side of the 4th.
- The area of the club house and surrounding gardens.
- When playing the 7th hole, the 6th is out of bounds.
- When playing the 9th hole, the 10th is out of bounds.
- When playing the 13th hole (do not go down looking for balls)
- When playing the 18th hole, the 5th is out of bounds.

2. OBSTRUCTION (RULE 24)

The following are immovable obstruction: distance markers front of the green (W : 150m, R : 130m, Y : 90m) concrete steps, stone paths, course furniture.

3. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

All old masonry, roads, ruined buildings, trees and rocks ...

4. WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26)

- All water hazards marked by yellow stakes.

5. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26)

- All lateral water hazards marked by red stakes
- Any unmarked ditches.

6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 25)

Tyre ruts made by course maintenance machinery are ground under repair from which the player may take relief under rules 25-1 all areas defined by blue stakes or appropriated marked.

ETIQUETTE AND GENERAL RULES

- Keep up with the match ahead, not ahead of the match behind.
- Please replace all divots, repair all pitch marks, and rake bunkers.
- Where possible, please keep buggies on concrete cart paths.
- No trolleys within 5 meters of greens or tees.
- Game to be played in accordance with the rules and etiquette of the royal and ancient Golf Club of St Andrews
